The **Sixth Marine litter monitoring** campaign in Burgas region is an action in the framework of the "Zero Waste Strategy for Good Environmental Status (ZEWSGES) – BSB257" project.

On 30.04.2020 the Pomorie Sandspit Beach was only monitored /the 6th monitoring/.

In order to reach project objectives following activities have been carried out:

- **The Beach was visited on 30.04.2020 by the project team.**
- **The "OSPAR Marine Litter Monitoring Survey Form" was filled in.**

The monitoring beach was fairly clean. It is obvious that before the beginning of the active tourist season the beach is cleaner than at the second clean- up campaign in September 2019 and the beginning of the monitoring activity under ZEWSGES project.

Predominant was the plastic waste / bottles and small plastic pieces/ and small pieces of paper.

### Conclusion and results

- ✓ The beach clean-up campaign in September 2019 and lack of tourists during the winter season, gives significant results and the beach is very clean.
- ✓ It could be concluded that the most of the litters comes from the people visiting the beach.
